AGILITY OBSTACLES

Obstacles: Agility Obstacles will be chosen from the current issue of the Official Rules and Regulations of the USDAA, Inc. www.usdaa.com as amended July 1, 2009.

CHECK-IN & MEASUREMENT

Competitors must check in during the scheduled time. Dogs requiring measurement must be measured prior to being checked in. All dogs must be measured unless they jump 26" (22" in Perf), the handler presents a permanent card, a temporary card with 3 signatures awaiting a CMJ or a check-in letter issued by USDAA / print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded. Should a dog be measured up and the dog is unprepared to jump the higher height the competitor may run For Exhibition Only, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no refunds will be given.

Saturday: 7:30 AM – 8:00 AM. First dog on the line at 8:15 AM

Sunday: 7:30 AM – 7:45 AM. First dog on the line at 8 AM

These times are tentative, they may change slightly depending on entries, confirmed times will be noted in your confirmation.

SITE INFORMATION

Check your final confirmation for site accessibility times.

This event will be held outdoors on grass. Ample parking and crating areas are available. **Indoor crating in building right next to the ring climate controlled \$20 for the weekend this fee is for up to four dogs per handler.** You may not share the fee with anyone else. There are restrooms within close proximity of the trial site.

There may be food concession on site. Several fast food restaurants are within 10 minutes of the trial site. Snacks and drinks will be provided for workers.

Please keep your dog on leash, at all times other than when preparing to run, running or using a designated area for dogs off leash. Please clean up after your dog and yourself at the event site. Those not cleaning up will be dismissed from the trial at the discretion of the trial committee.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE Davis County Fairgrounds/Legacy Arena

Traveling from the North: Take I-15 South or Hwy 89 S. from Ogden, Utah. Exit at the Park Lane (Lagoon) Exit 325. Head south-west on Park Lane (it will curve around and become 11th West). The Fairgrounds will be on your left.

Traveling from the South: Take I-15 North from Salt Lake City. Exit at the Park Lane Exit 324 (just past Lagoon). Bearing to the right, you will turn left at the light onto Park Lane. Stay on Park Lane West as it will curve to the South and becomes 11th West.

As the U.S. representative of IFCS, USDAA will be sending a team to Europe for the 2010 World Agility Competition. To kick off the fund-raising, USDAA asks that you consider making a donation. Class Descriptions and Eligibility

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, Advanced, Masters and Performance 1, 2, and 3 levels at this event: Gamblers, Jumpers, Pairs Relay, Snooker and Standard.

A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3 - 7 of the Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations.

Note that effective 1/1/09, Pairs will be required for versatility titles in Performance. Should only one dog be entered in a program / level, a partner from another program/level may not be solicited to make a qualifying pair.

The following tournament classes are being offered at this event:

- Grand Prix of Dog Agility®
- Performance Grand PrixSM
- Dog Agility Steeplechase®
- Performance Speed JumpingSM

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships & Performance Grand PrixSM Championships Local Qualifiers:

These single-round tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of skill level or titles earned and are judged under Masters rules. Competitors earning ZERO faults shall earn a qualifying score. The first place dog/handler in each jump height earning a qualifying score will be awarded a 'bye' in the final round of a Regional Championship. One qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional Championship and two (2) qualifying scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the world championships.

Dog Agility Steeplechase® & Performance Speed JumpingSM: These two-round tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of skill level or titles earned and are judged under modified Starters rules. A qualifying score is earned in Round 1. In Steeplechase one qualifying score is required to enter Round 1 of a Regional qualifier and two scores are required to enter the quarterfinals at the world championships. A 'bye' may be earned in Round 2 of a regional championships. In Speed Jumping two (2) qualifying scores are required for entry into the semifinals at the world championships.

The A-Frame is set at approximately 5'6" for the 12" & 16" jump height and at approximately 5'10" for the 22" & 26" in all Championship test & tournament classes and at approximately 5'6" for all Performance test and tournament classes.

*Redesigned long jump; P8" dogs jump 2nd board only.

AWARDS

All Agility Test Classes: separate first through third place ribbons will be awarded in each class for each jump height. Pairs will be awarded for mini and open first through third place. Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those dogs earning qualifying scores.

Grand Prix/Performance Grand Prix: Placements will be awarded to 1st - 3rd in each jump height. See class descriptions online for complete details.

Dog Agility Steeplechase: Details regarding Prize money offered for Round 2 can be found in the class descriptions at the USDAA website.

Performance Speed Jumping: Prizes shall be provided at the club's discretion. See class description online for details.

NOTES TO COMPETITORS

Competitors through submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA® rules and regulations, as amended July 1, 2009, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

- All dogs must be registered with USDAA® and have the appropriate U number prior to the competition date in order to compete. Registration may be made concurrently with this entry to this show, a form for which is included in this test schedule. OR to receive a registration number immediately and height card before the show, go online to www.usdaa.com. Click on General Information, Dog Registration.
- This event is open to all dogs at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression. No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No training, pinch, or shock collars will be permitted on or around the course at any time.
- The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date, or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from the competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal or for bitches that come into season after the closing date.
- **No changes in jump height or program entered will be accepted after the closing date.**
- It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any competitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, may be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler. No refunds for overpayment of entry fees will be made for less than \$5.00.
- **There will be no equipment familiarization.**

- Running order will be determined by random draw. Efforts will be made to separate the dogs of a single handler in a given class.
- Fault limits may be imposed in any class, at the discretion of the organizing committee/judge.
- All handlers for a given class should be present at ringside at least one half-hour prior to the start of scheduled classes for walk-through and judge's briefing. Any dog and handler not present when their number is called will be ineligible to run.

Competitors through submission of entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.

Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS and HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indication of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known. All competitors and handles hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.
