We are limited to up to 40 runs per day for sheep and up to 8 for ducks for a total of 40 runs per day so we could have 32 sheep and 8 duck runs or any combination to total 40 runs. We will take day of entries if there are runs available but each run will have a \$10 late fee added. 5 head will be used both ducks and sheep.

HTAD trials will be Course #2

Sheep will be a gather and a ribbon pull, ducks will be take a pen and a touch.

Location – The River Bottoms 13600 South Lovers Lane

Exit Draper Riverton exit off I-15 (12300 South) go West to 1300 west. Turn left on 1300 west go approx 1.5 miles through the “S” curve and down the hill. There is a small road near the bottom of the hill that goes into the trees. This road will be on your left (This is Lovers Lane). Follow small one lane road on your right not to far will be a driveway with a barn and an old run down farm turn there you will then go down a dirt road through 2 gates and you are there.

Please remember it is your responsibility to bring proper shade, seating, refreshments and proper attire for the weather conditions. Also if it is a hot weekend and you want clean water for your dog to lay in please help us out by bringing 5 gallons of water to use in the dog tubs as we have to haul in any fresh water.

As used here "AHBA" means the American Herding Breed Association, their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

Exhibitor/ owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of AHBA and any other rules and regulations appearing in the flyer for this event.

Exhibitor /owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

Exhibitor /owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the roads, arenas, fields, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

Exhibitor/owner release AHBA and sponsoring organization/Wasatch Agility (including its officers, directors, volunteers, and event organizing committee), the site owner (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor /owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.

Exhibitor/owner is responsible for any damage to stock and agrees to pay either veterinarian bills or pay the fair market value of the stock.
